

## To be eligible for CPAP:

- Need to have a disability.
- Interested in advancement through education/training.

## Individuals who qualify must meet **ONE** of the following criteria:

- Case closed successful with Nebraska VR in one of the following career pathways: Architecture/Construction; Healthcare; Information Technology; Manufacturing or Transportation/Distribution/Logistics (TDL) AND wants to seek opportunities to advance within **any** career pathway.
- Currently employed in one of the five designated career pathways/clusters AND wants to advance within the **SAME** career pathway through education and/or training.
- Interested in one of the five career pathways/clusters AND wants to advance by completing short-term trainings to obtain multiple credentials within the **SAME** career pathway.
- Interested in completing one of the CPAP/Nebraska VR Certificate programs.
